The foundation of Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University) was laid in the village Jamunipur, Kotwa in the Phulpur parliamentary constituency by late Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru in 1962 with a dream to establish a center of higher learning in rural India. This vision of the first PM of India came to fructification in 1996 when Shri J. N. Misra (a former Bureaucrat) helped establish a Degree college in Jamunipur, Kotwa. This college grew to become a Deemed University in 12 short years, in 2008. Today NGB has 500 teaching and administrative staff; more than 5000 UG/ PG students, 400+ research scholars with 27 teaching departments - ranging from traditional subjects to professional programmes. The focus of the University remains to offer quality education in an affordable and accessible manner to the folks in rural area of Prayagraj. Major Discussion Points

The points of discussion includes: Introduction to the AI – esp in domains of Higher education in social sciences and applied subjects; The handling of evolving roles of teachers, students, and technology in classes. The ethical issues, and hands-on applications of relevant AI tools. The sessions will be handled by known experts in the subject, with adequate time being allocated for demonstration, application, and Q&A to iron-out doubts, etc. Discussion on various tools for preparation, conduction, and evaluation assistance. Use of case studies is envisioned.

The primary audience are the Faculty members, and IQAC coordinators/members, from the Indian Universities, esp. those above the age of 50 years of age.
