Detailed Report of the
Open Forum Meet on 23.11.2021 organized by Dean (Student's Welfare)
of Honb'le VC and Honb'le PVC
with Students on their Academic Problems

Vide a Public Whatsapp Notice dated 22.11.2021, Dean (Student's Welfare) invited 5 students from each of the departments to the open forum meeting chaired by Honb'le VC and PVC for on spot appraisal of all current academic problems being faced by the students at large. Director Jamunipur Campus Dr. P. K. Mishra alongwith Chairmen Admission Committee Dr. Vinod Pandey, Dr. Adinath HOD (Botany), Dr. Shrawan Kumar, Asst. Professor (Teacher Education) conducted the meeting in supervision of D.S.W. Dr. Chhaya Malviya. Dr. R. C. Tripathi, Prof. Incharge (R & D) also attended the meeting apart from Dr. D. N. Pathak, Dr. Abhishek Mishra & Dr. Sadhana Tripathi.

2. At the outset, D.S.W. made a hearty welcome to Honb'le VC and PVC and the students gathering. She emphasized that this is the 1st meeting of its kind to capture on spot all the current academic problems of the students by the highest authority to mitigate them timely. Honb'le VC Dr. S. K. Srivastava addressed the students gathering to make free fair unbiased and true problem statements being faced by them in regard to examination results, offline and online classes, Classrooms, teachers, contents, library facilities, issue of books, conducting of lab practicals etc.
3. The Student's Feed Back Form was also distributed asking the students to fill it up and submit back to the D.S.W. About 200 such feed back forms duly filled in by the students are attached with this report alongwith attendance sheet, photographs of this open session etc.
4. The analysis of feed back forms in the form of pi chart showing percentage of students retorting each of the main problems-type is also attached in this report giving a feel of the intensity and the type of the problems.
5. Some main problems noted in the open forum include conducting of even semester classes on regular basis, sincerity of teachers, upkeep of practical labs organizing field visits, issue of books, cleanliness in the ladies washrooms/bathrooms, problems of classrooms, availability of teachers, student's own problems of attending classes in meager strength, issue of last examination marksheet to apply for government scholarships etc. Some specific cases mentioned in the forum were as below:

- (i) BA History 3rd year time table not circulated so far.
 - (ii) No classes of even semester started so far in Political Science, Education, Post Graduate classes in Mathematics, Botany, Chemistry & M.Ed.
 - (iii) Instruments/Equipments/Apparatus in some of the practical labs were non functional.
 - (iv) Some students showed their concern for delay in issue of last semester marksheets to enable them apply for government scholarships.
6. Honb'le Vice Chancellor asked Prof. R. C. Tripathi about the progress in our access to e-books for which efforts are made recently. Prof. R. C. Tripathi informed all the students that with initiative taken by Honb'le VC and PVC our university has become member of world e-book library through DELNET, New Delhi enabling all of us to access about 20 Lakh e-books from any of the computer system in any of the campuses of NGB (DU) or through smart touch phones connected through wi-fi to any of these personnel computers.
 7. Very soon e-library will also be set up providing student cabins and network connected personnel computers for access of above e contents even by those students who presently have no smart touch phones.
 8. Honb'le Pro Vice Chancellor informed the student's gathering that all library books have already been shifted to Central Library building in Shashi Campus, Juthi Tali and are being arranged in almirahs and racks where after the problem of issue of books will be solved for ever. He also informed that almost all results of previous exams have been declared and notified on our website except a few which will be also announced within a week or so.
 9. Honb'le VC informed that all the problems raised by the students will be solved soon on the system level. However, for the individual problems, the concerned student should approach his/her Teachers/HOD/Dean as per the requirement type and level.
 10. After distributing small refreshment to the students, the meeting ended with thanks to the Chair.



6. The teacher encourage participation and discussion in the class




7. The Teacher uses modern teaching aids, handouts, suitable references, power point presentation, web-resources, etc










1. The sequence of the courses (subjects) in the curriculum




2. Size of the syllabus in terms of the load on the student






4. The Offering of the electives in terms of their relevance to the specialized stream




5. How do you rate the electives offered in relation to the technological advances





In regard to the Faculty, Teaching Learning and Evaluation, main concerns of the students, as per above table are reported as:

- i. Use of Modern ICT teaching aids,
- ii. Laxicity to follow schedule for conducting periodic assesment and
- iii. Completion of the Course in time.

Due action has been taken to equip at least one classroom in each of all six faculties to have one ICT enabled classroom. The Lecture Hall for Ph.D. Course work has also been ICT enabled. With lecture recording facility installed in all major subsidiary campuses, PowerPoint included lecture videos have been recorded, edited and made available to the concerned students. Course completion in time after COVID-19 Pandemic becoming over in September 2021, this is been taken due care by addressing by the top authorities, all the departments and faculties through regular visits to each of the 26 departments.

Student Satisfaction Survey in regard to "Curriculum Quality Indicator" in Overall is VERY GOOD. Almost 90% students rated it to be strong (High + Moderate). However Students have expressed their concern to:

- i. Knowledge domain being addressed by practicals/lab experiments,
- ii. Electives being offered somewhat insufficient to include current technological advances and being relevant to the specialized streams. These issues have been well taken note of and will be addressed in future.
